By train to Ambergate

Our offices are an easy walk from Ambergate station which has an hourly service from Derby with most trains originating at Nottingham.

For timetable and fare information ring National Rail Enquiries on 08457 48 49 50 or visit www.nationalrail.co.uk.

To get to the offices from Ambergate station exit the station and turn right at the bottom of the station approach, away from the A6 and the Hurt Arms. The walk from the station takes about 5 minutes. You will see the offices through large green metal gates on the left just before the railway bridge. Walk past the Country Furniture Showroom to the door at the rear of the building and ring the bell to gain access.

By train from the North and North West

The quickest journey is to take the train to Alfreton which is about 20 minutes away from our offices by road. There is an hourly direct service Liverpool - Manchester - Sheffield - Alfreton and also an hourly Leeds - Sheffield - Alfreton service.

Either take a taxi (book in advance on 01773 836100) or we'll pick you up.

By car from the North/South via the M1

Leave the M1 at junction 28 and take the A38 south towards Derby. Leave the A38 at the junction for the A610 towards Ambergate (opposite direction to Ripley). The offices are about 3 miles along this road on the right hand side just after the railway bridge. If you get to the A6 (Hurt Arms) T junction you have gone too far.

You are looking for a brick built building - Ambergate Country Furniture. Enter by the green gate and our entrance is at the end of the building around the back.

By car from the A6

Ambergate is north of Belper and south of Cromford. Turn off the A6 at the Hurt Arms onto the A610 towards Ripley. The offices are about a quarter of a mile on the left before the railway bridge.

You are looking for a brick built building - Ambergate Country Furniture. Enter by the green gate and our entrance is at the end of the building around the back.
