

# How to get to Doubletree by Hilton Sheffield Park

## By train

Our recommendation is for you to take the train. The nearest mainline stations are Sheffield and Chesterfield (which offers a quicker journey if you're coming from the south). The nearest local station to the hotel is Dronfield. Trains from London leave St Pancras station.

There are taxi ranks at both Sheffield and Chesterfield stations but not at Dronfield. From Sheffield, the fare will be around £10 for a 20 minute journey, from Chesterfield £15 for a 15 minute journey and from Dronfield pre-book with Network Taxis on 01246 417417, around £5 for a 5 minute journey to the hotel.

## By car

**By car from the North** - Leave the M1 at Junction 33 and join the A630 to Sheffield. Continue along the dual-carriageway and follow signs for the Ring Road, Chesterfield (A61) for approximately 5 miles. Continue over two roundabouts and at the third roundabout turn left. Continue until you pass Graves Tennis Centre on your left, and at the next roundabout follow the sign for the A61 Chesterfield, M1 South. The hotel is 200 yards on your left hand side.

**By car from the South** - Leave the M1 at Junction 29 and join the A617 to Chesterfield. Follow signs for the A61 Chesterfield, then follow signs for the A61 Sheffield. After the City of Sheffield boundary sign, you will see the hotel on the right hand side. Continue to the roundabout and double back.

**By car from Sheffield City Centre** - Follow the signs for the A61 South (Chesterfield). Approximately 5 miles from the City Centre at the traffic island, continue on the A61 and the hotel is 200 yards on the left hand side.

## By air

**By air** - For international travellers in particular, we would recommend Manchester Airport which has a station at the airport with hourly direct trains to Sheffield. East Midlands Airport is also an option but getting from the airport to East Midlands Parkway or Derby station can be a bit messy unless you know what you are doing.
